# **Current Membership and plan**

- Actually : 8 general practionners, all academics
- Plan :
  - Recruiting through Asthma Right Care and congress
  - Extend to other general practionners, especially non-academic
  - Extend to other professions : physiotherapists, nurses, Advanced Practice Nurses, therapeutic education nurses, pharmacist
  - Extend to other specialities : pulmologists (but in France, mostly in tertiary care), pediatricians



## **Educational Activities and Plans**

#### Actually :

- Full member of <u>Asthma Right Care</u> for France
- Spirometry training in primary care at the national congress of general practice and universities
- Member of the scientific committee of the E-respir congress
- Translation work for IPCRG

#### Future

- Production of a prescription support website for asthma and COPD
- Depending on the recruitment of other professionals : participation in nursing and pneumological congresses





# **Current Research Activities and Plans**

#### Actually

- Systematic review on the diagnosis of asthma in children < 6 years old
- Systematic review and meta-analysis on the treatment of asthma in adult

#### Expected

- The CAPAST study : Effectiveness of the Evaluation and Communication of "Pulmonary Age" as Help for Smoking Cessation. NCT04276116. Funded by a national public grant. Study star date: November 2021.
- The GLORI COPD study : Screening of COPD Patients at Risk of Complications in General Practice. NCT04027296. Funded by a national public grant. Study start date: September 2021.
