





# Deliver objectives efficiently, with effective cost control, raising income to invest in projects and infrastructure for which fundraising is more challenging

- Two strategy teams: Asthma Right Care and COPD Right Care
- First accreditation with EACCME, with Education committee support
- Research Leadership Team led Scientific Programmes for Málaga and Munich
- Relationship building with Wonca, ICRN, HIFA (health information for all) and FIP
- Increased use of technology: translation, dubbing
- Implementation of our <u>triple bottom line</u>
- Asthma Right Care in low income countries eg Bangladesh; support for pharmacists
