## What is the duration of immunity from vaccination?

### What the research says

As SARS-CoV-2 vaccines have only recently been developed, the nature and duration of immunity they offer is currently unknown and studies are ongoing to address these questions.

### What this means for your clinical practice

- SARS-CoV-2 vaccination should be offered to all eligible individuals according to local guidance.
- As the duration of immunity provided by SARS-CoV-2 vaccination is not clear all patients, regardless of vaccination status, should be advised to continue to observe social distancing and infection control measures according to local guidance.
